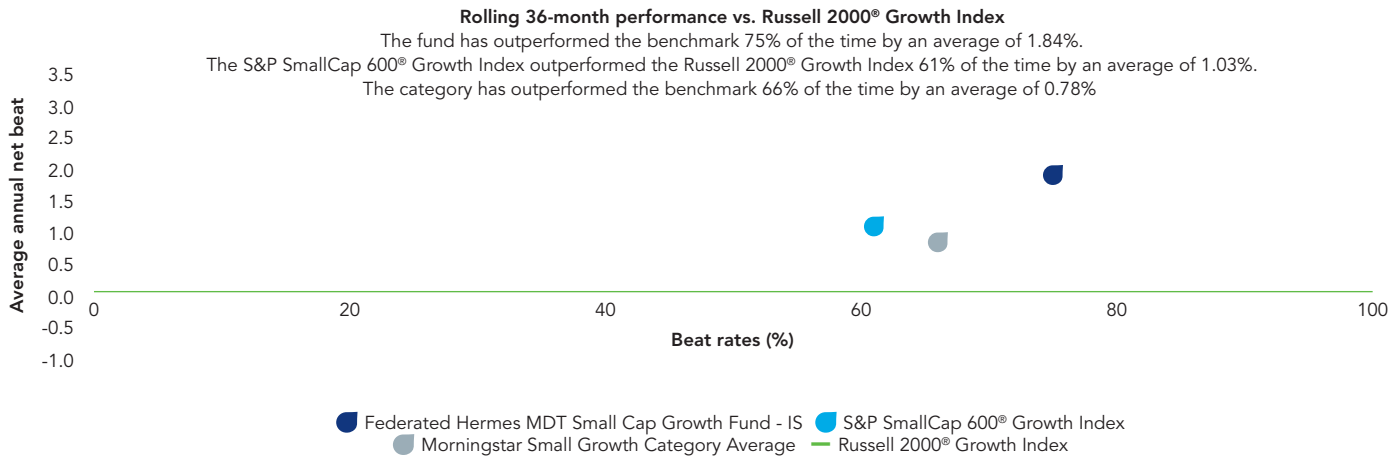


## Record of outperformance

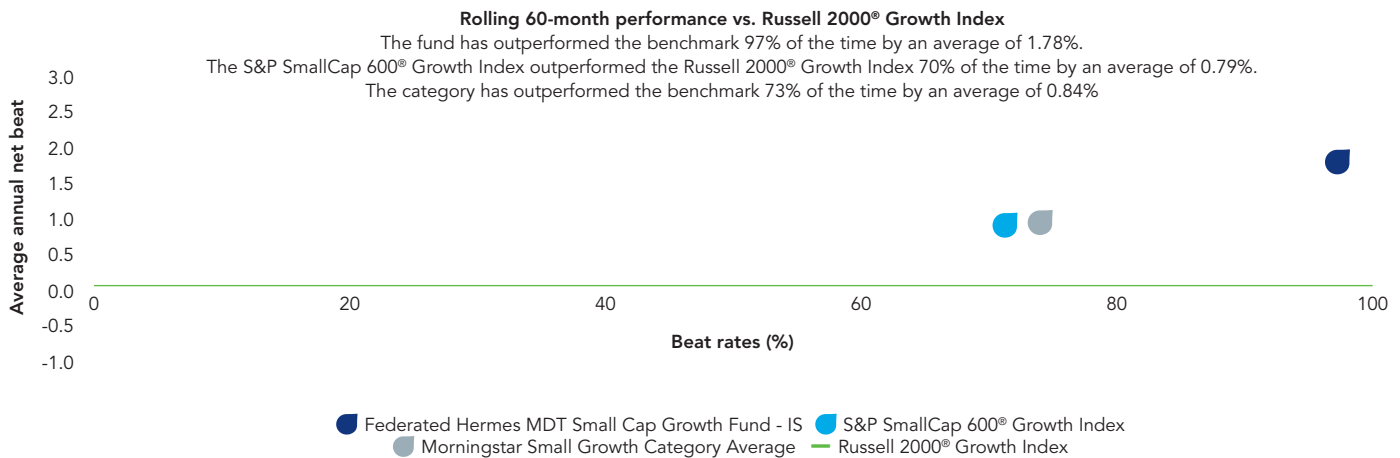

### Definitions
